



# **City of Pembroke**


- Pive Council members and a Mayor

  The district is noted for its high graduation rate (94.1%
  in 2023-24) and strong performance in test scores.
  Rural/Suburban: Pembroke has been described as having a "sparse suburban feel" while maintaining a "classic rural community" identity. The city is in the more rural northern part of Bryan County.
  Housing: Most residents rent their homes (56%), and the median property value in 2023 was \$169,800.


