ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING  
FEBRUARY 6, 2020  
Great Wolf Lodge  
LaGrange, Georgia

President Richard Osborne opened the annual meeting of the Georgia Association of Zoning Administrators (GAZA) at 4:18pm with approximately one hundred members in attendance.

Minutes of the previous business meeting held on August 22, 2019, in Savannah, Georgia, were distributed to all in attendance. After review and discussion, William Geer made a motion, seconded by Scott Morgan, to approve the minutes as written. Unanimous approval.

Copies of the current financial report were distributed to all in attendance. Norman Pope, Treasurer, gave a short report on revenue and expenses of the Association.

Mike Mastrario made a motion, seconded by Scott Morgan, to approve the financial report as submitted. Unanimous approval.

The scholarship committee reported that Smith Kaiser from Statesboro, Georgia, was the winner of the Betty Gecoma Scholarship for 2019 – 2020. The deadline for the 2020 – 2021 scholarship applications will be May 31, 2020.

Membership Committee reported that the current 2020 membership numbered 132 members, and all in attendance were reminded to send in their renewals if they had not already done so.

Legislative Committee reminded everyone to carefully watch HB302 as it currently moves through the Georgia Legislature.

Randy Mannino, Chairman of the nominating committee, presented to the membership a proposed slate of officers for 2020 – 2021.

Nominations were requested from the floor. None were received. New slate of officers were elected by acclamation.

Chairman Mannino submitted the names of Mike Mastrario and Jeanne Anne Marsh to serve four year terms on the Board of Directors. Term would run through the end of 2023. Nominations were requested from the floor. None were received. Mike Mastrario and Jeanne Anne Marsh were elected by acclamation.

The GAZA Summer Conference will be held at Lake Lanier Islands Resort in August of 2020, and the Winter Conference will return to the Continuing Education Center on the UGA campus in Athens in February of 2021.
