Minutes of the previous board meeting held in Carrollton, Georgia on October 11, 2022 were not available due to the illness of Secretary Janet Hyde.

A financial report was distributed to all in attendance. Treasurer Norman Pope gave a short report on income and expenses of the Association. After review, Ethan Calhoun made a motion, seconded by Jeanne Anne Marsh, to approve the financial report. Unanimous approval.

The number of registered guests for the Winter 2023 Conference currently stands at 112 people according to Sharon Fenneran from UGA.

Ethan Calhoun reported on the GAZA website and the typical items members are seeking information about. Many are simply wanting to confirm membership.
